It is organized and operated exclusively for public, charitable, educational, literary and cultural purposes as a 501(c)(3) tax exempt corporation.

holiday party where we

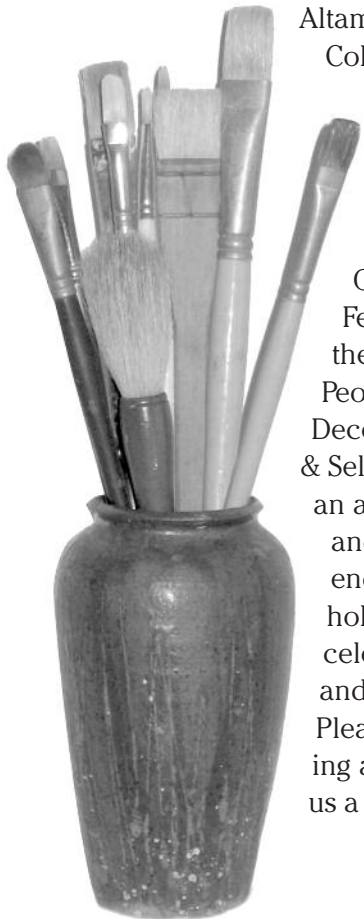
